



SNOWSPORT ENGLAND APPEALS PROCESS

All appeals must be made in writing, with accompanying evidence and any additional Information, to the Snowsport England office. For England Alpine Squad, selection(s), appeals must be made within 2 weeks after the Selection Panel's announcement of the members.

All Appeals will be considered on an individual basis. Appeals will first be reconsidered by the original selection committee who will explain their reasons for the decision to the athlete or legal guardian. If the athlete or legal Guardian is not satisfied with either the process or the outcome of the Selection Committee's final decision, then the athlete may refer the matter to an Internal Appeals Committee.

The Snowsport England Appeals Chairman will constitute an Internal Appeals Committee made up of at least three people who did not sit on the original selection committee.

In the case of appeals against non-selection to the SSE Squads, those making appeals should understand that an Internal Appeals Panel is not tasked to substitute its own view for those of the original selection panel. The Internal Appeals Panel is only asked to determine whether, on all of the facts they had—or should have had—before them, the original selection committee made a reasonable and fair decision using the currently applicable selection policies.

For appeals against squad selections SSE requires a bond of £50, which is returnable should the appeal be successful, but not otherwise. In exceptional circumstances this bond may be waived.
