2. Minutes of last meeting (17.3.16) and matters arising:-

Minutes formally approved to include the amendment made by TA re Silkworth event during NSSW.

- Letter circulated to clubs and regional chairs completed by VC.
- CSP's contacted by CC & VC
- Facility visits for NSSW on the agenda.
- SSE joining instructions on Web-page on the agenda.
- PR stunt on the agenda.
- Liaise with Andorra re posters completed by VC
- Liaise with facilities re press release completed by BG
- Date arranged to meet with Mark Vernon (EESKIA) completed by BT.
- Next conference call arranged completed by CC.Formally approved after a change of text relating to the event at Silkworth slope.

3. SSE Website.

- VC reported 2,800 hits on schools landing page since February 2016 of which 1,700 were unique hits. Average browse time was 68 seconds.
- Only 1% of visits moved onto the schools' page. Most stayed on NSSW page.
- VC has built the new web site but not yet known when it will go live.

- JD reported that it will be circulated in the next 2 weeks and then further time will be needed for approval.
- DM & VC agreed to discuss this further off-line. VC will send information to DM.
- DM asked if the sign up to membership of SSE could be more prominent on the NSSW page (perhaps as a side banner). VC agreed to pursue this.
- CC stressed the need to get schools involved (especially schools new to skiing) and then follow them up to get a SSE sign up.

4. National Schools Snowsports Week

- CC reported high interest at Gloucester, Bracknell, ERSA, Impulse and Ackers. Low at the moment at Tamworth
- VC reported that Chill Factor are still putting their offer to schools together as schools' link person has just left.
- CC will circulate feedback form next week.
- JD stressed the need not to upset 7 years of development work with slopes by being too demanding.
- We must keep sponsors happy.
- VC would only direct sponsors to events where a committee member was going to be present.
- JD/VC agreed to put together a briefing sheet for YDC members so that we all 'on message'.
- BG reported that the launch would go ahead on 22.4.16 at Hemel, although a
 celebrity had not yet been booked. Ian Brown had confirmed that Hemel
 would host the stunt. Aimee Fuller has confirmed that she will be in
 attendance.
- DM & BG agreed to discuss the launch event by phone early next week.
- CC confirmed that we would not invite the sponsor to the launch.
- VC confirmed that Sponsors materials will be co-ordinated at the SSE office and then circulated by courier to the slopes. Andorra goodie bags would also be circulated to be handed out to participating pupils.
- BT agreed to get joining instructions to SSE into these bags.
