BSA GBR Bursary

The BSA bursary prizes are for overall combined series age group top three places, male and female: Two weeks at our base in Italy with 100% fee bursary for 1st, 60% bursary for 2nd, and 40% bursary for third. If a first place bursary is declined then the three awards are passed down to the 5th placed racers in that category.

Included in Bursary:

Flights & transfers, race excursion supplements and entry fees (away from Aosta Valley), BSA 2018 registration fee.
